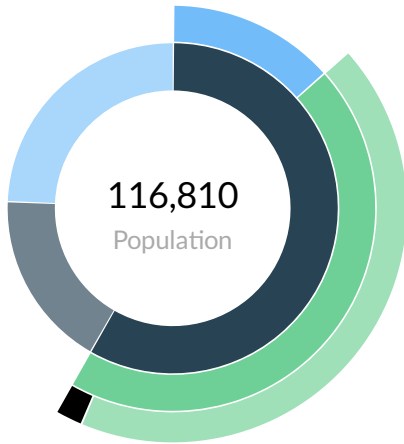

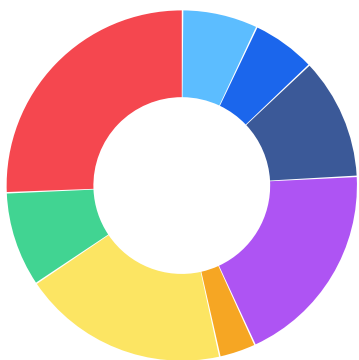

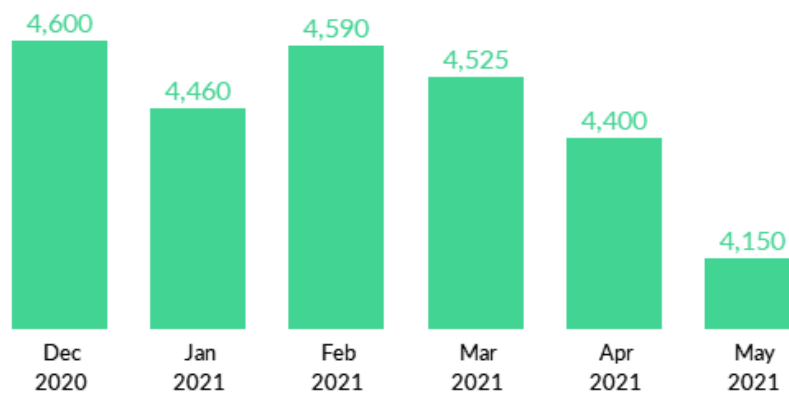

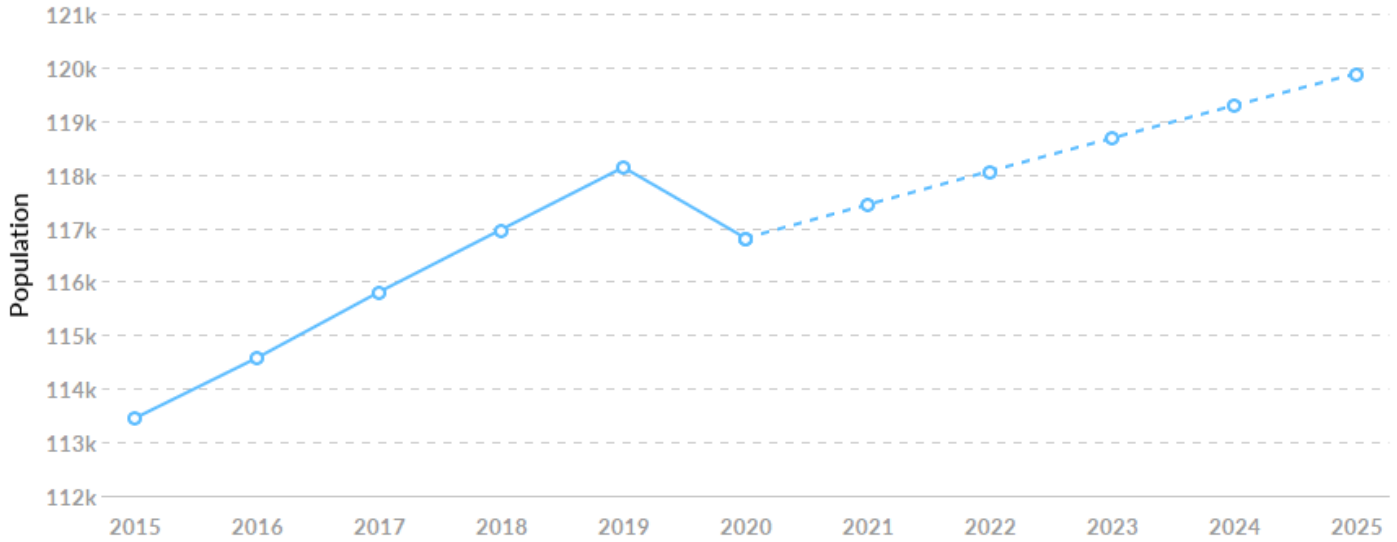

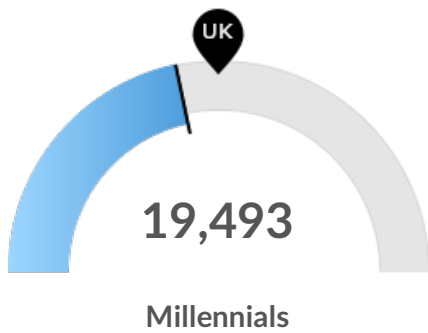
## Job Trends

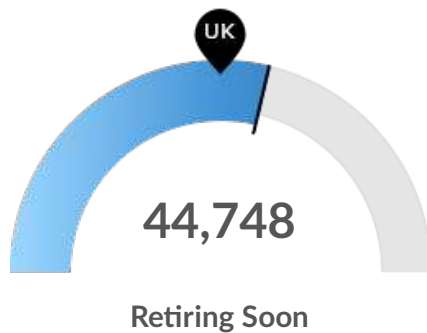

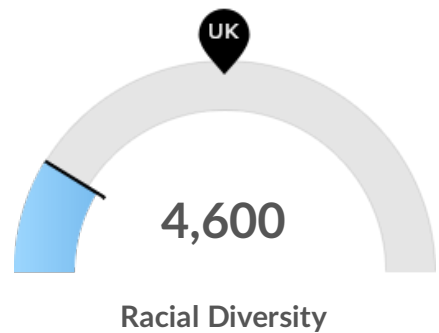
## Population Characteristics

Retirement risk is high in Dover. The national average for an area this size is 36,318 people 55 or older, while there are 44,748 here.



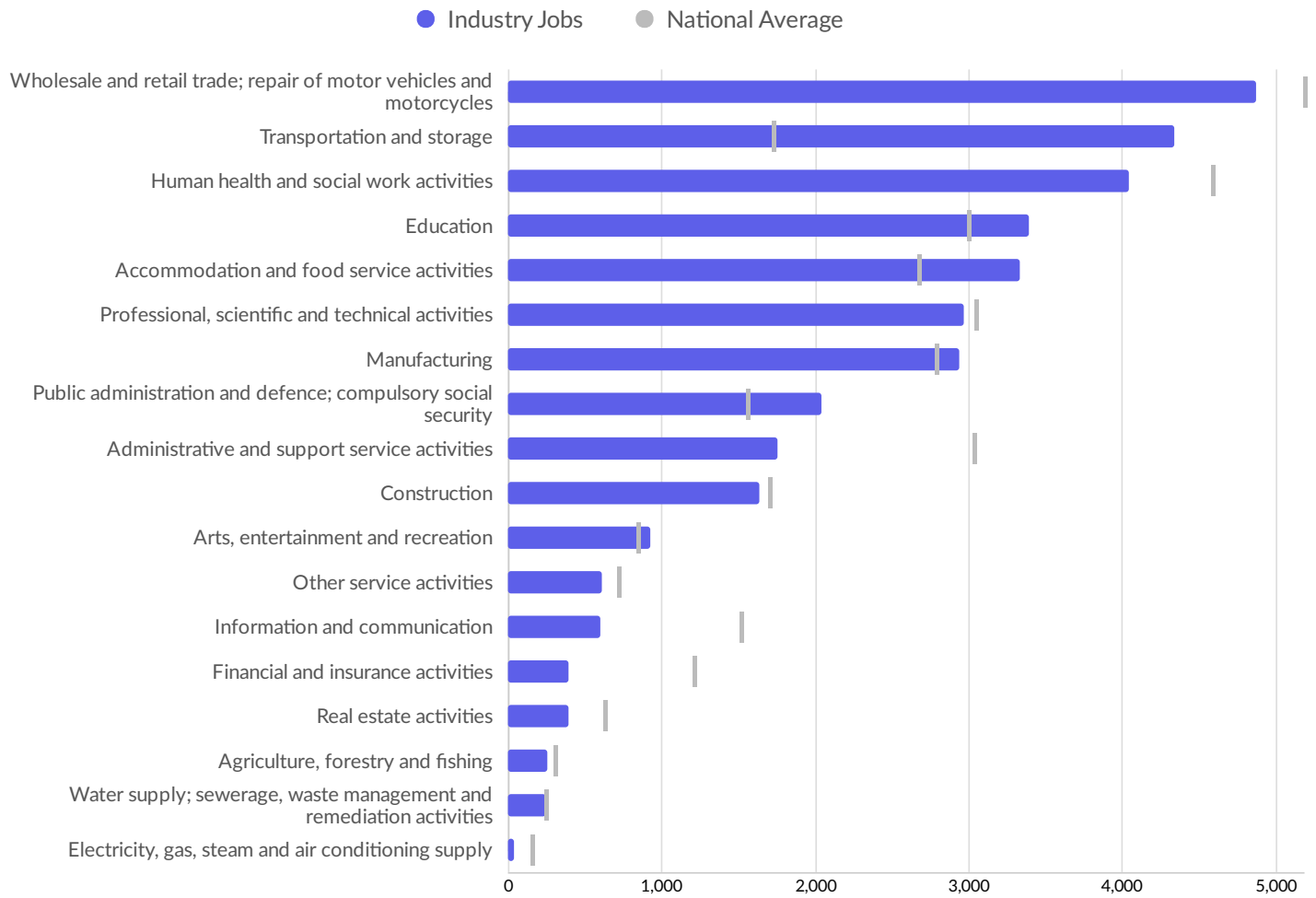
Racial diversity is low in Dover. The national average for an area this size is 16,583 racially diverse people, while there are 4,600 here.

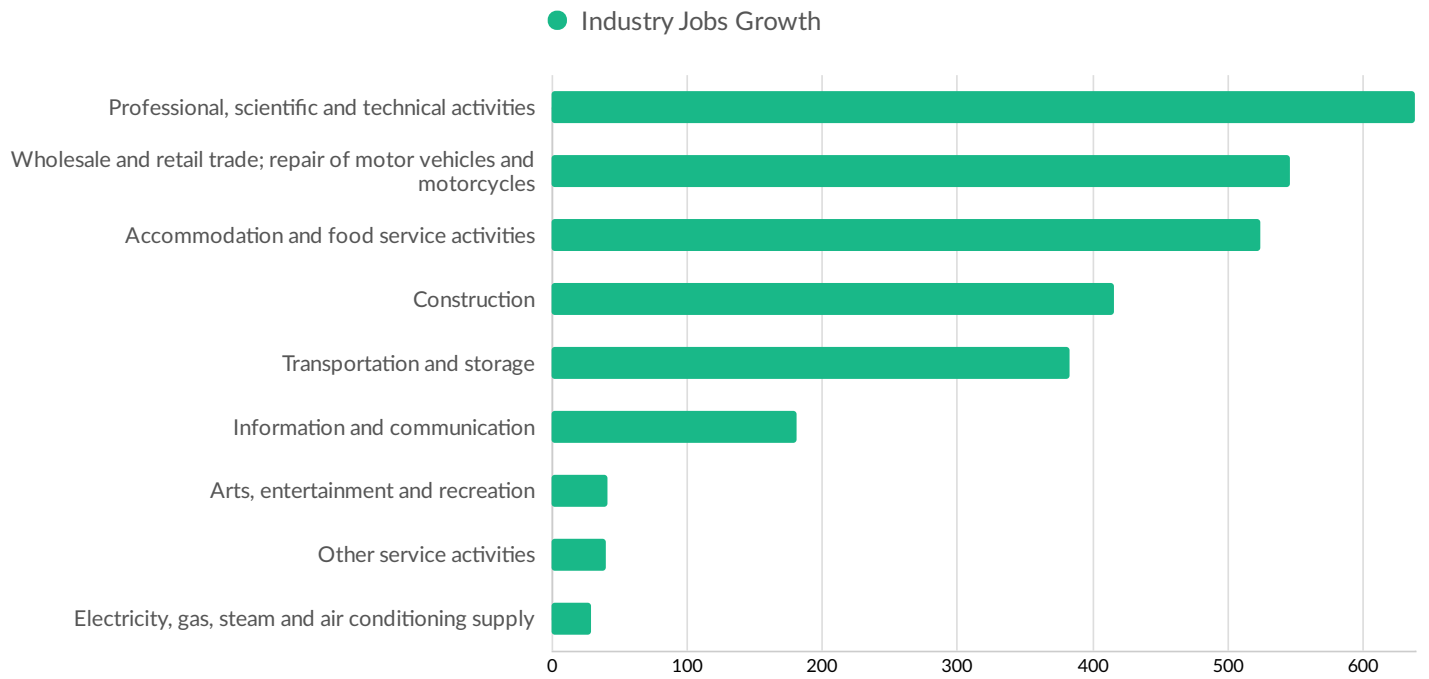

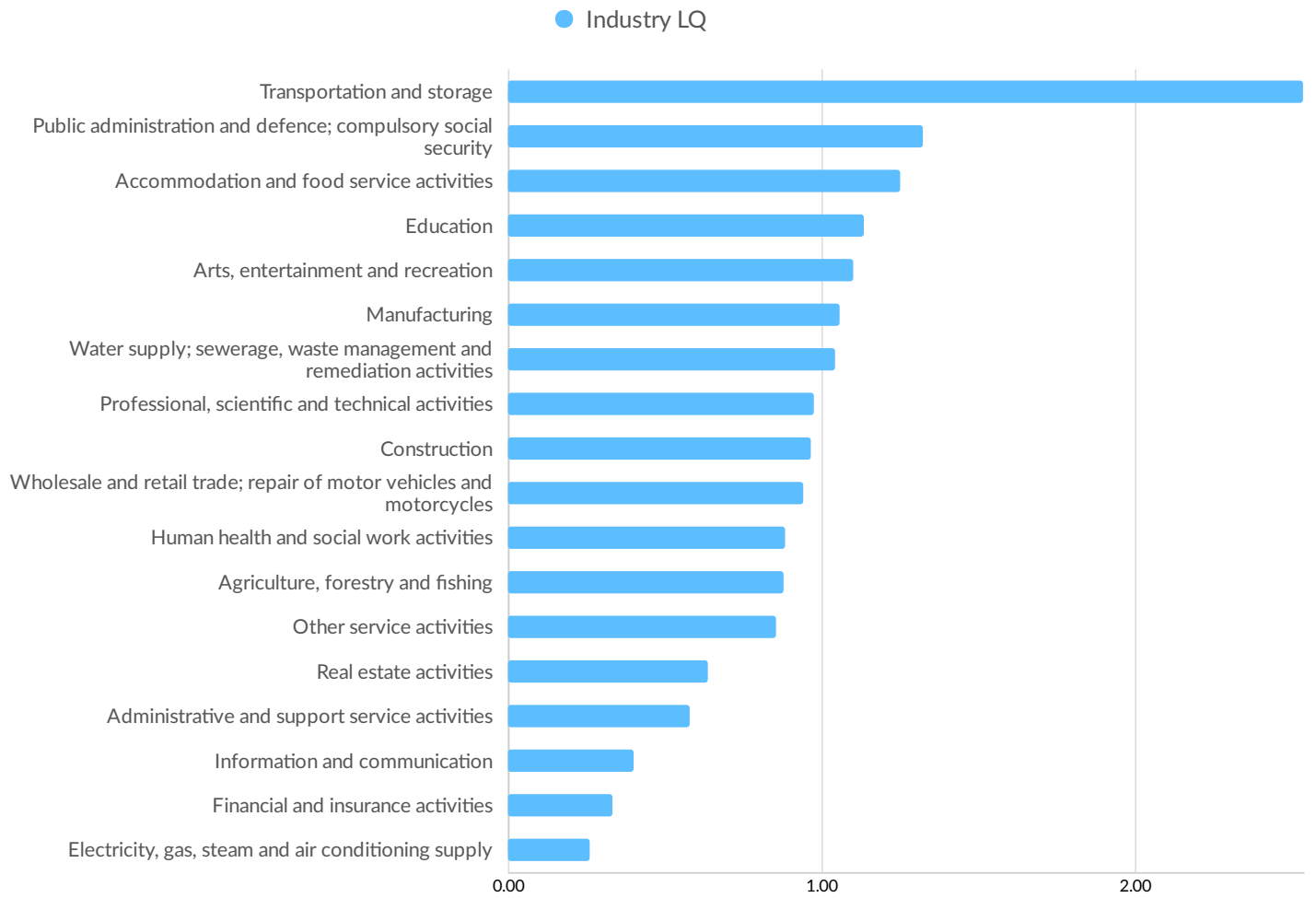

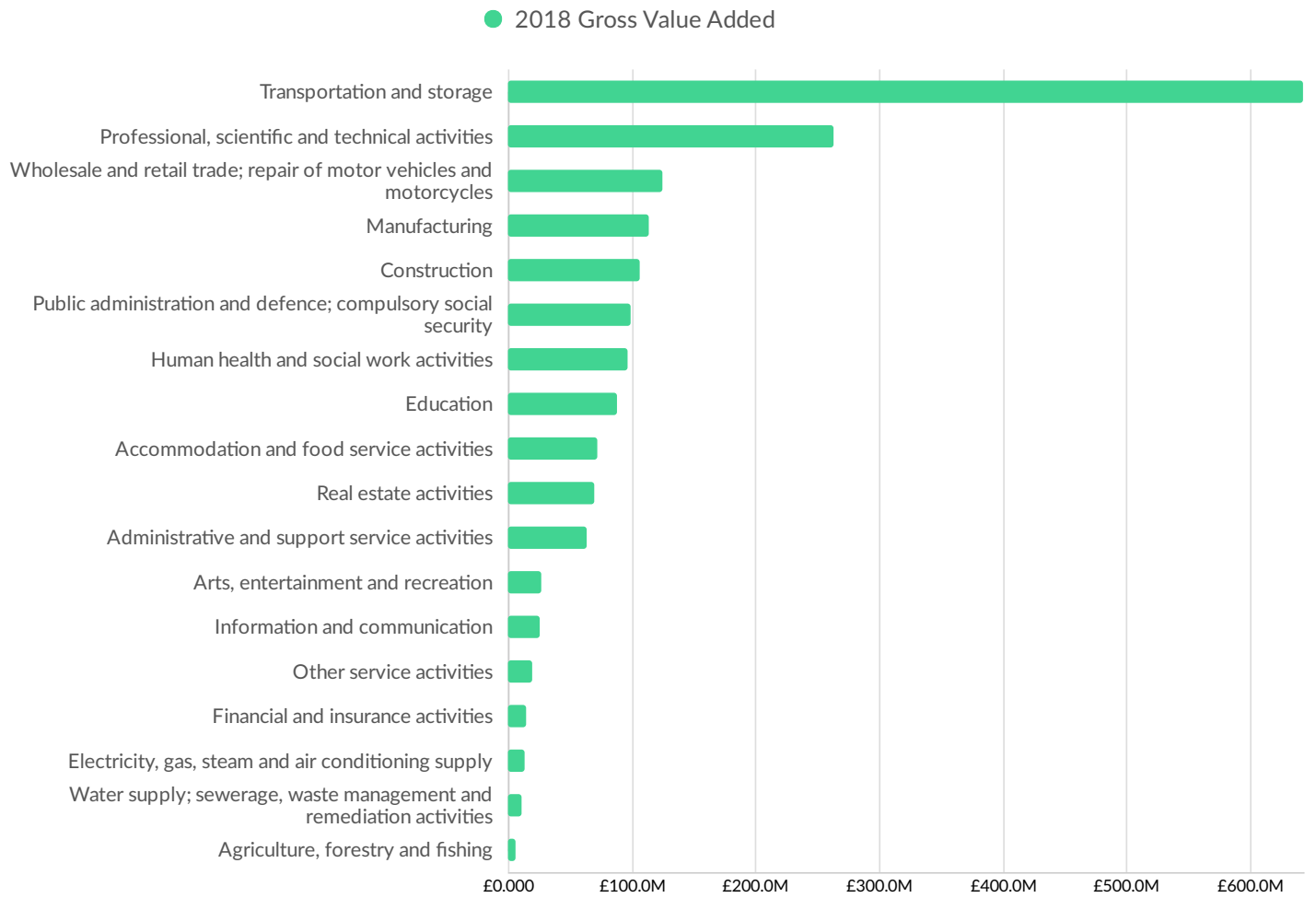
## Top Growing Industries



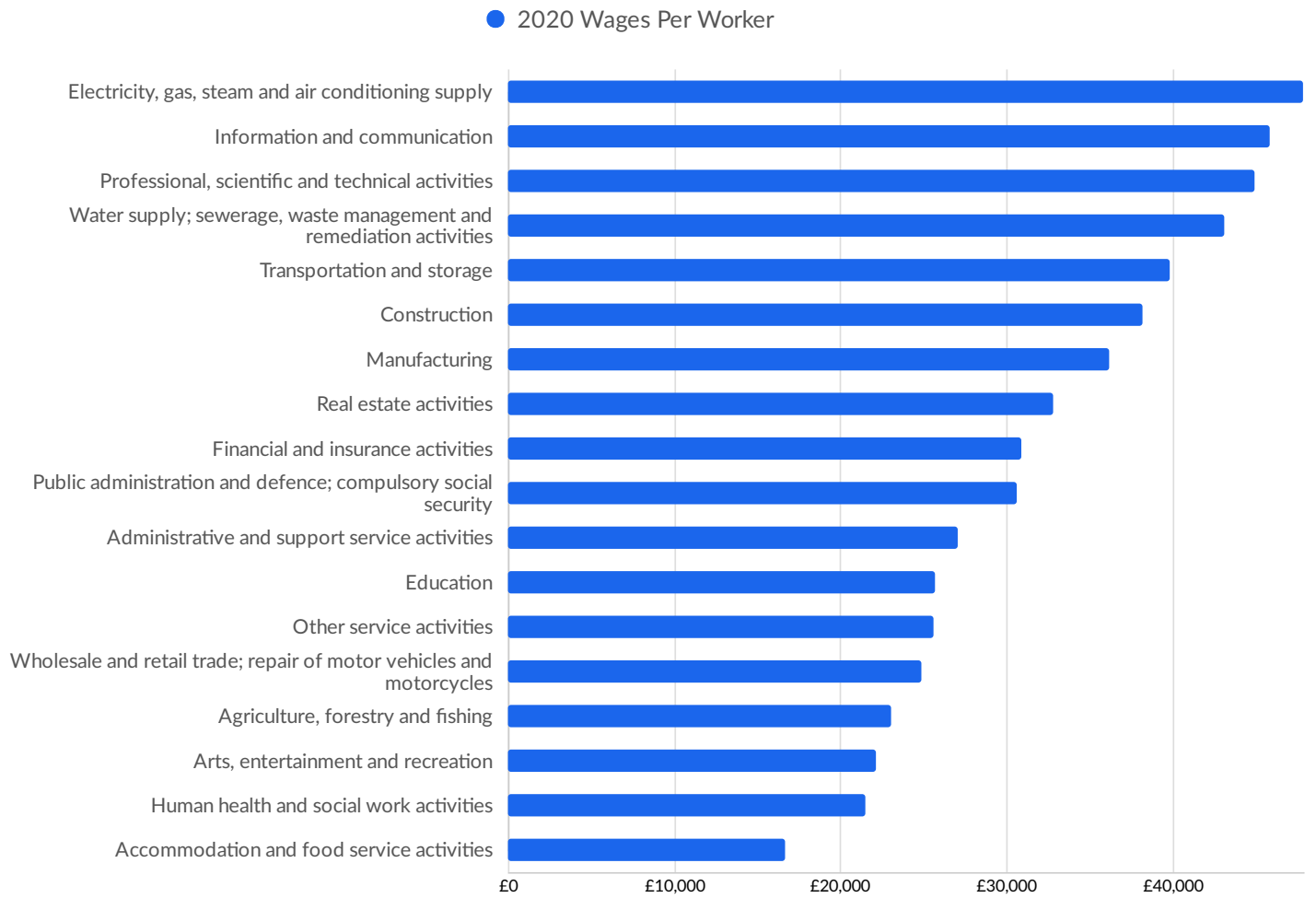

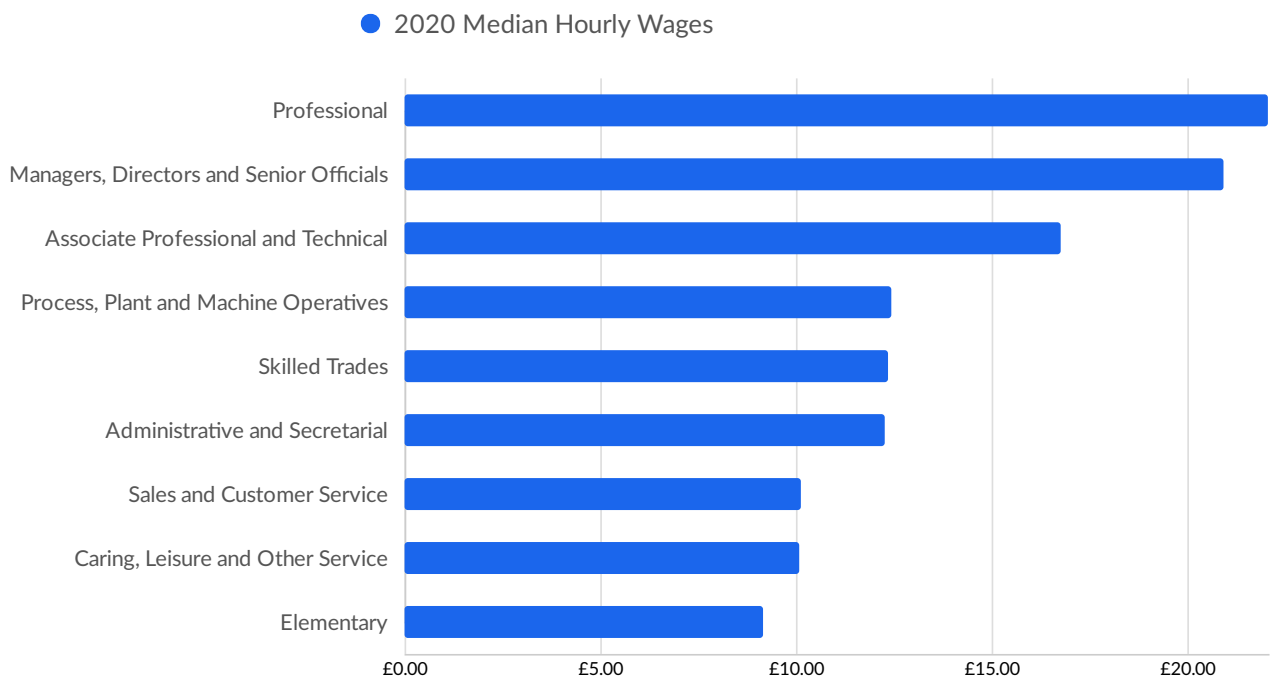

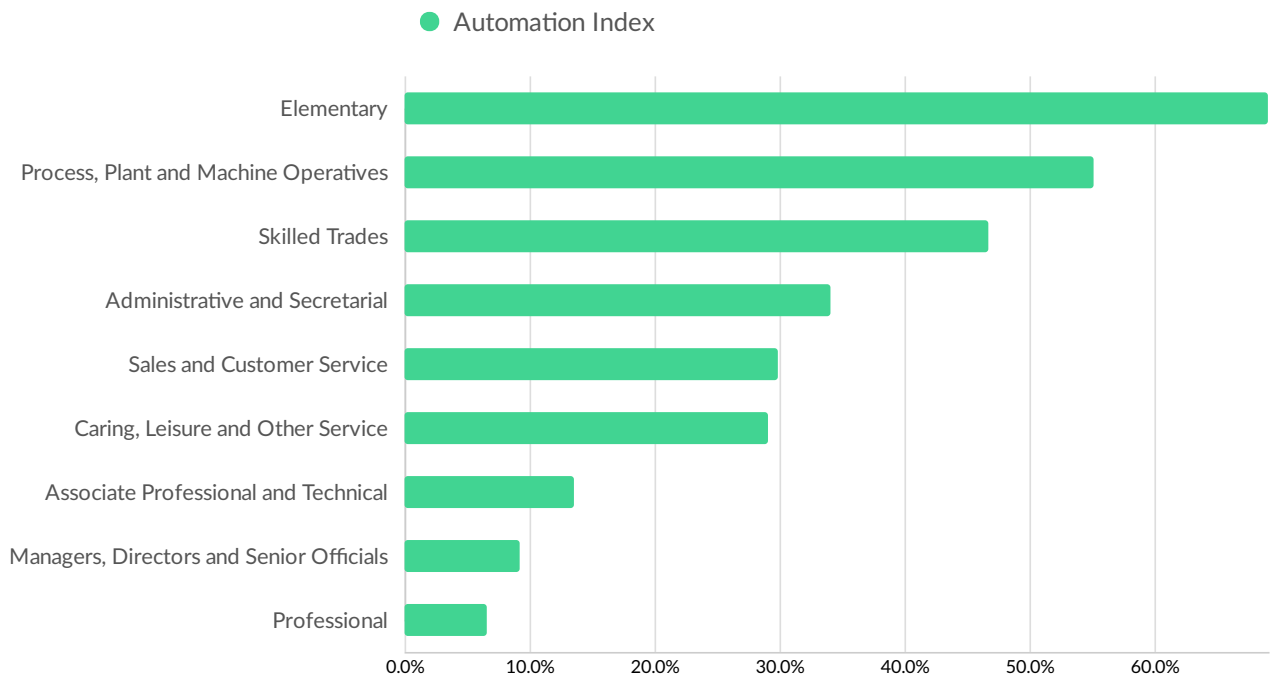
