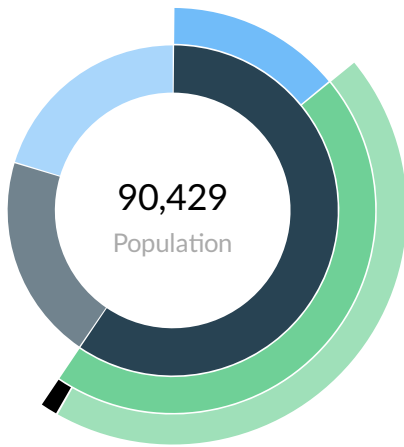

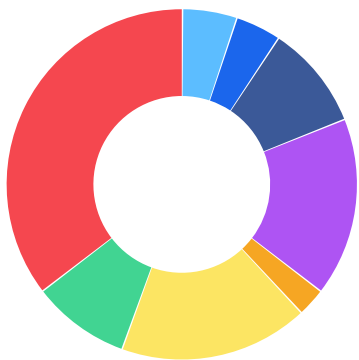

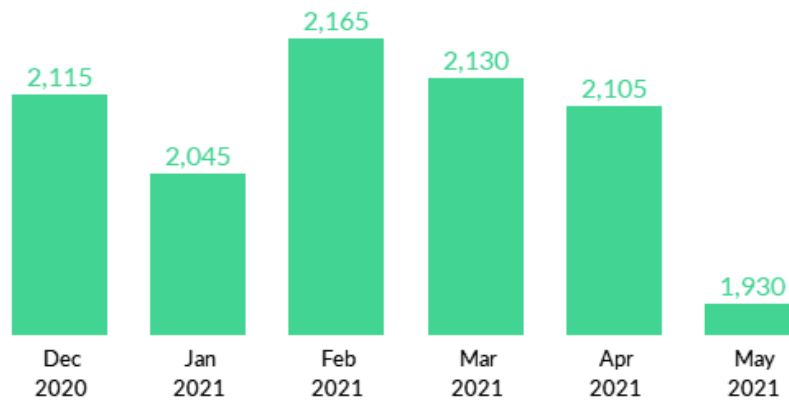

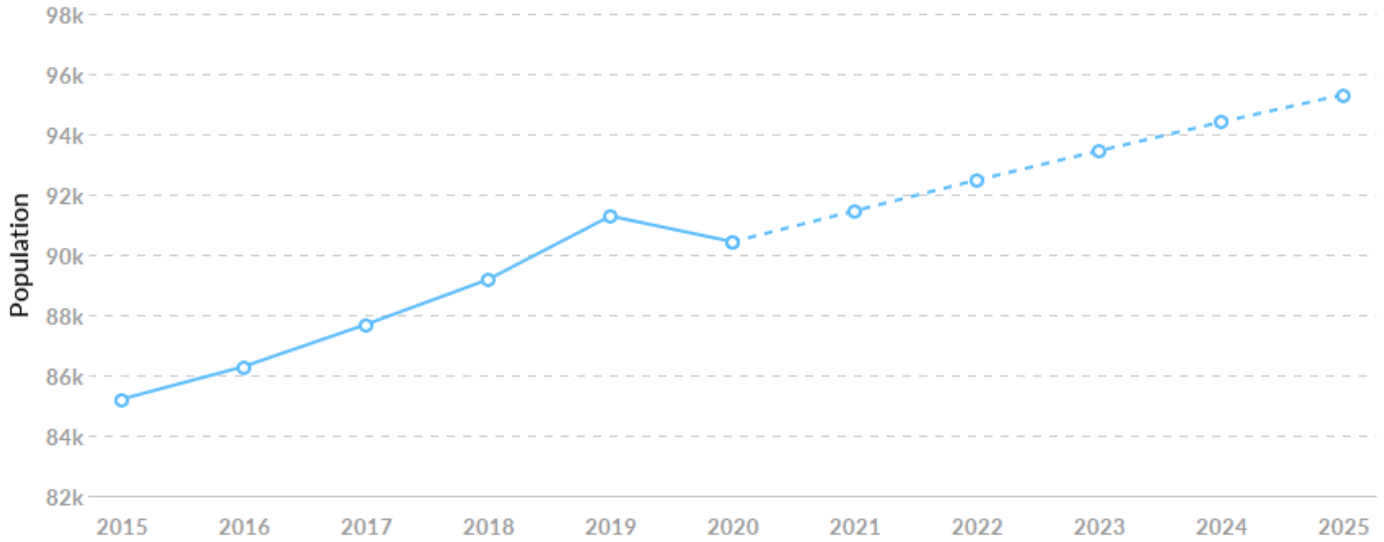

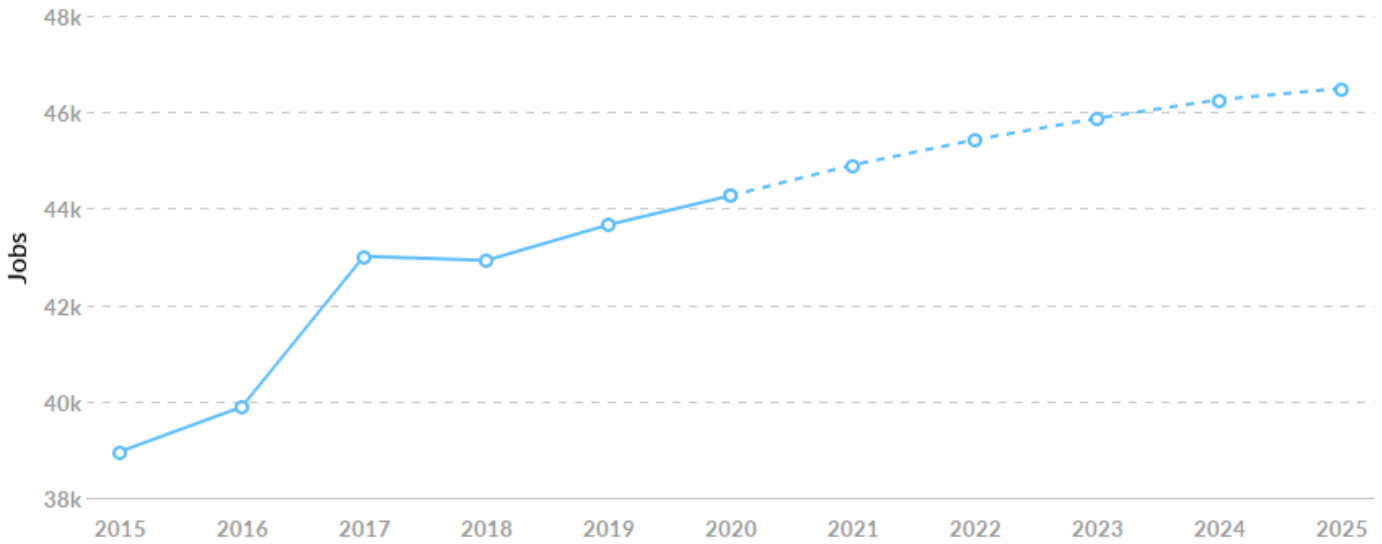

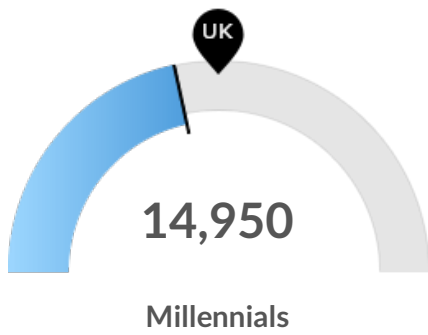
Job Trends

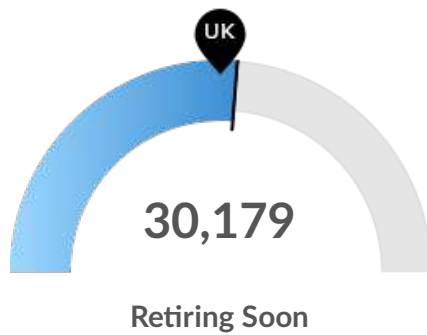

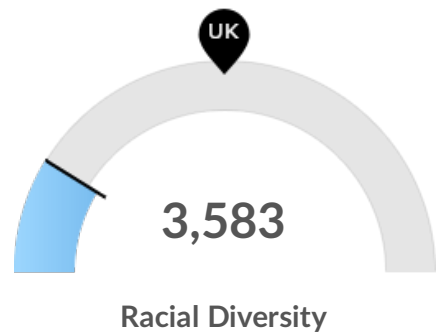
Population Characteristics

Retirement risk is about average in Uttlesford. The national average for an area this size is 28,064 people 55 or older, while there are 30,179 here.



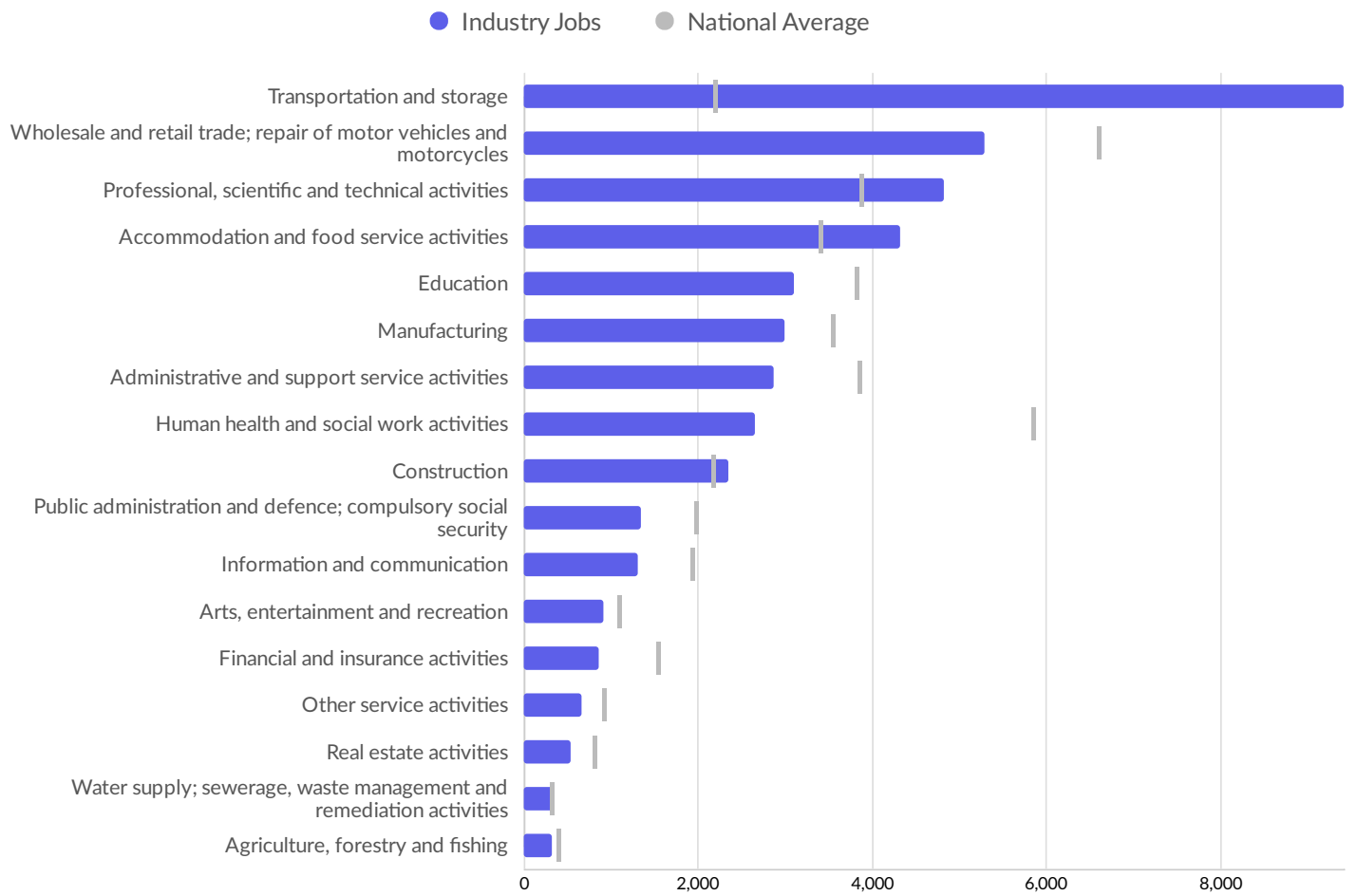
Racial diversity is low in Uttlesford. The national average for an area this size is 12,815 racially diverse people, while there are 3,583 here.

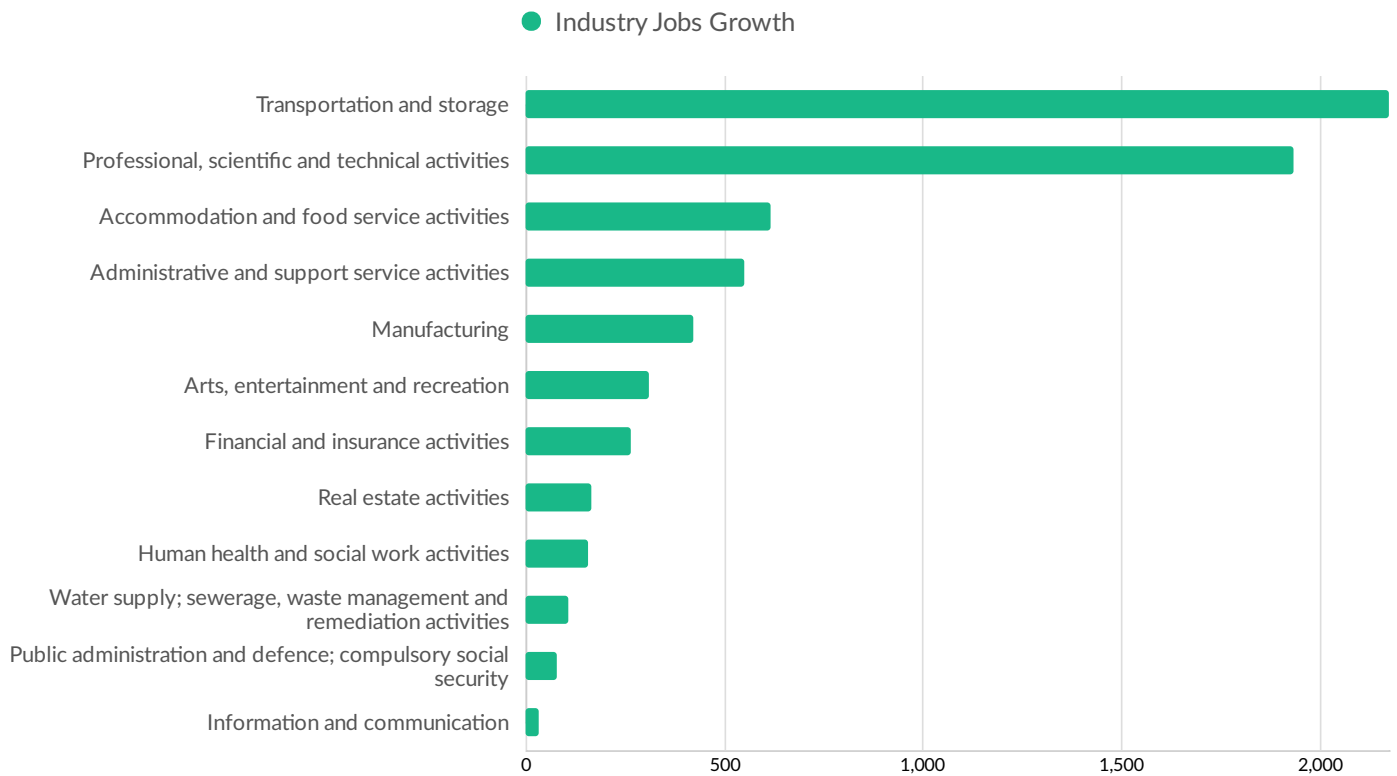

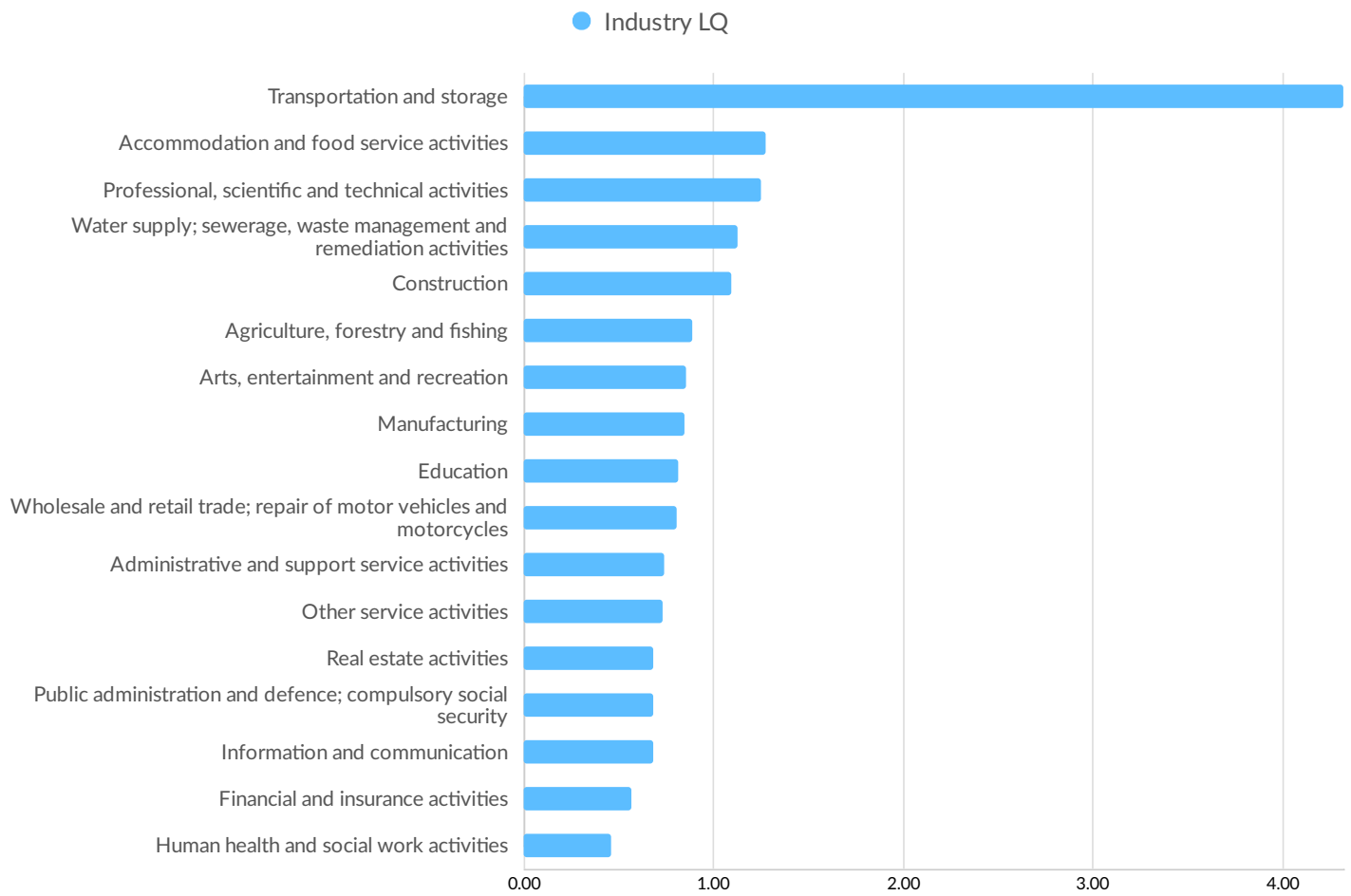

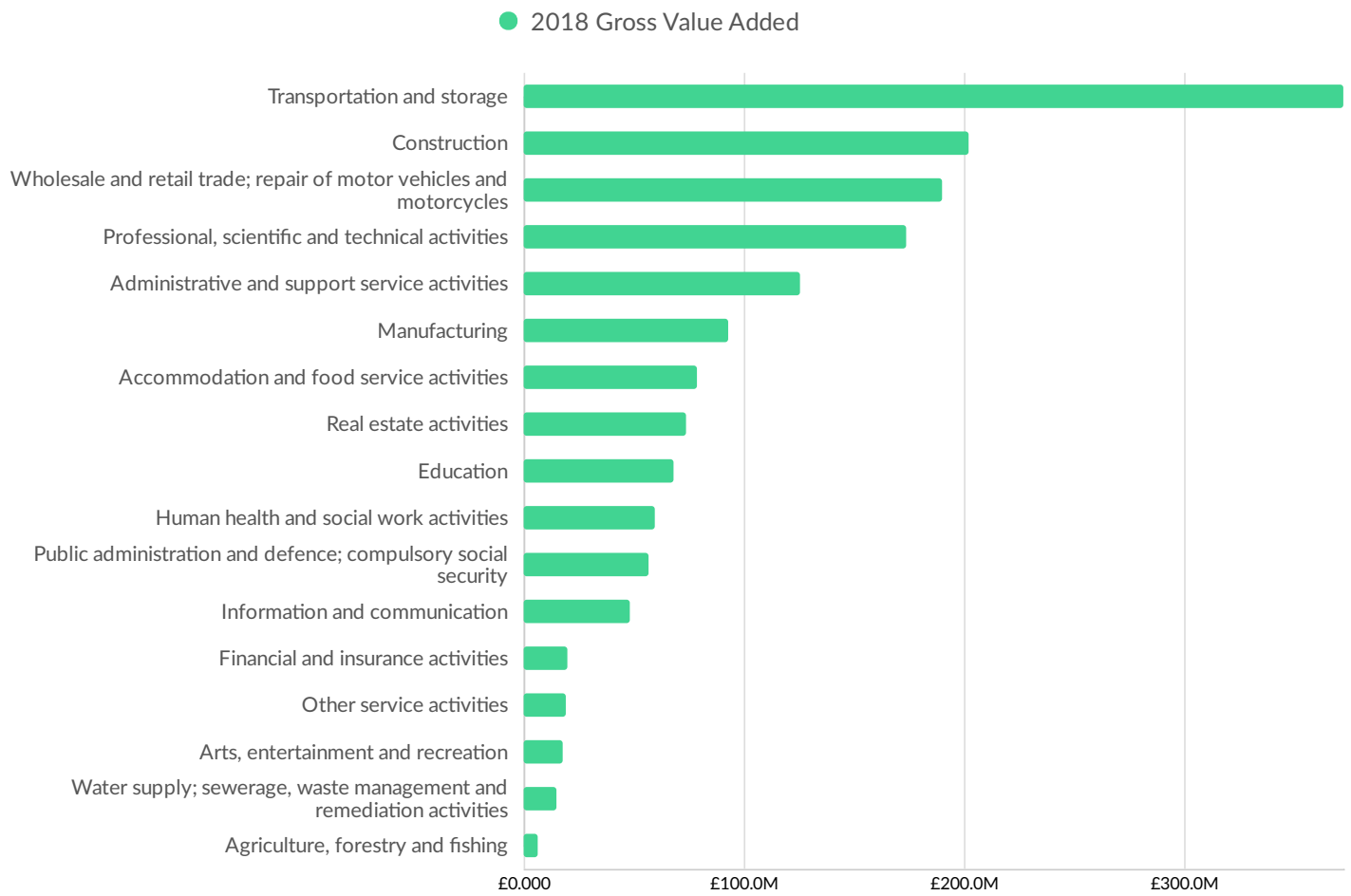
Top Growing Industries



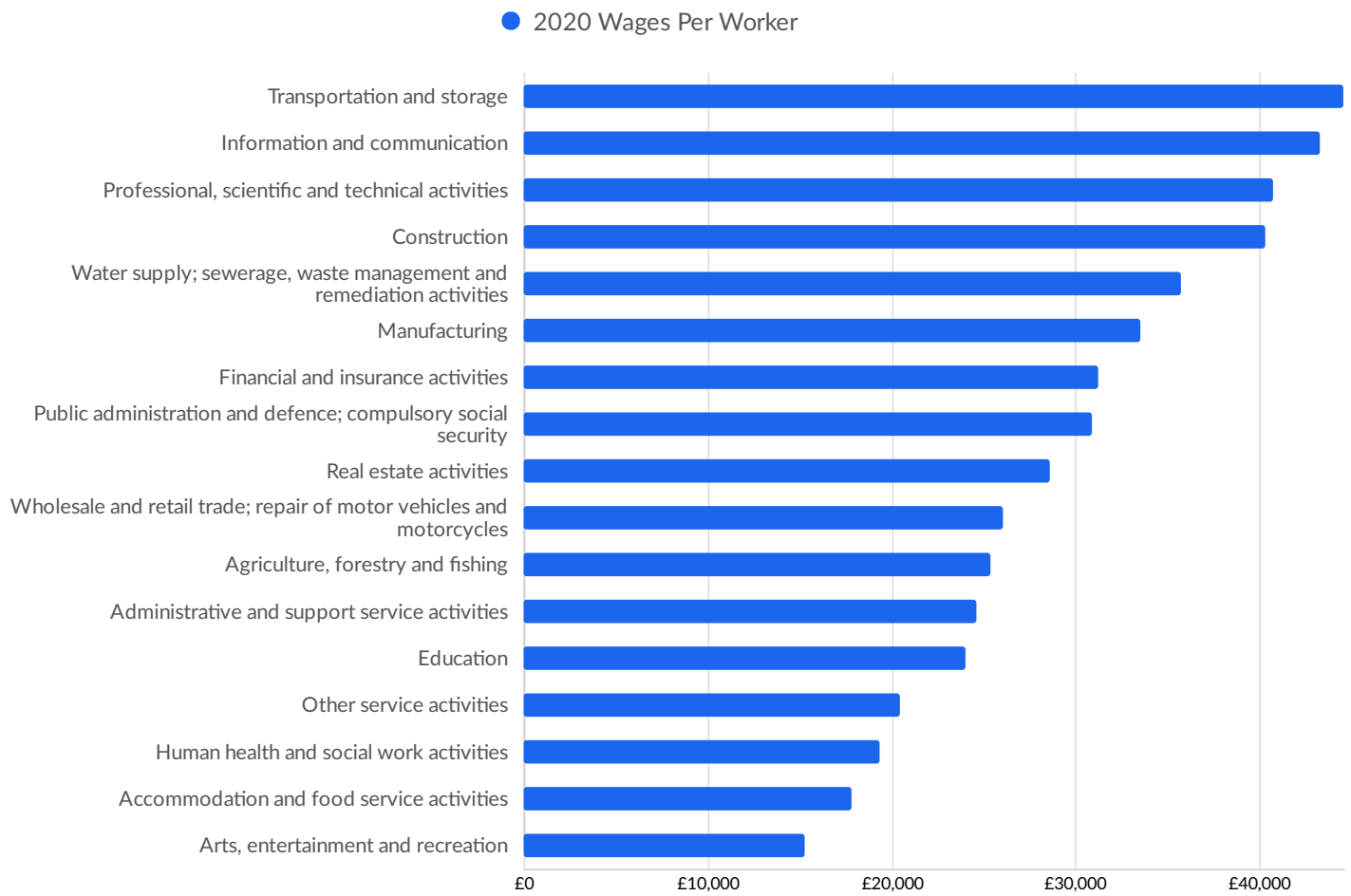
Top Industry LQ



Top Industry GVA

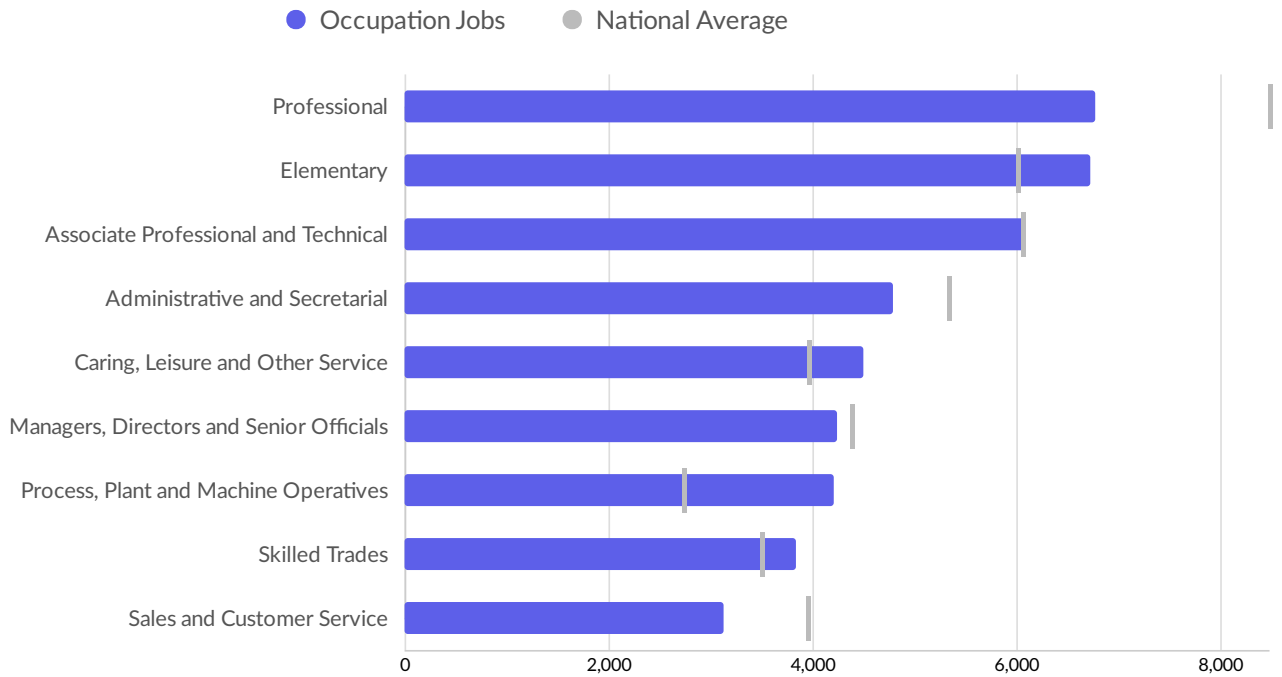


Top Industry Wages

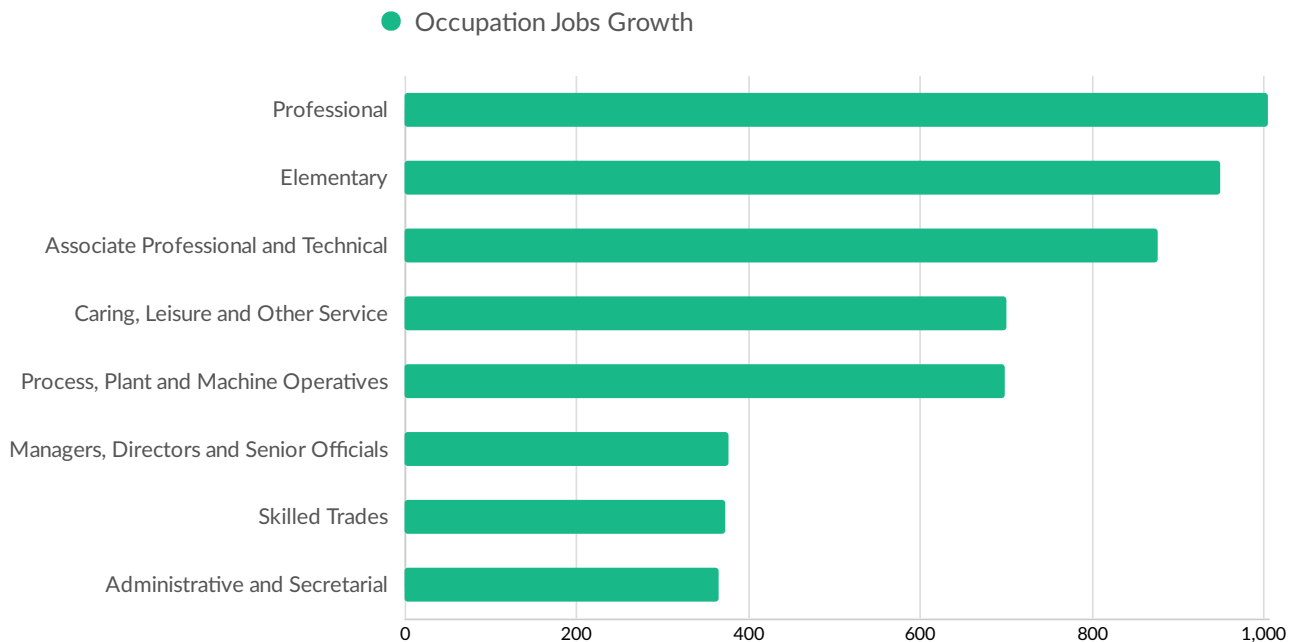

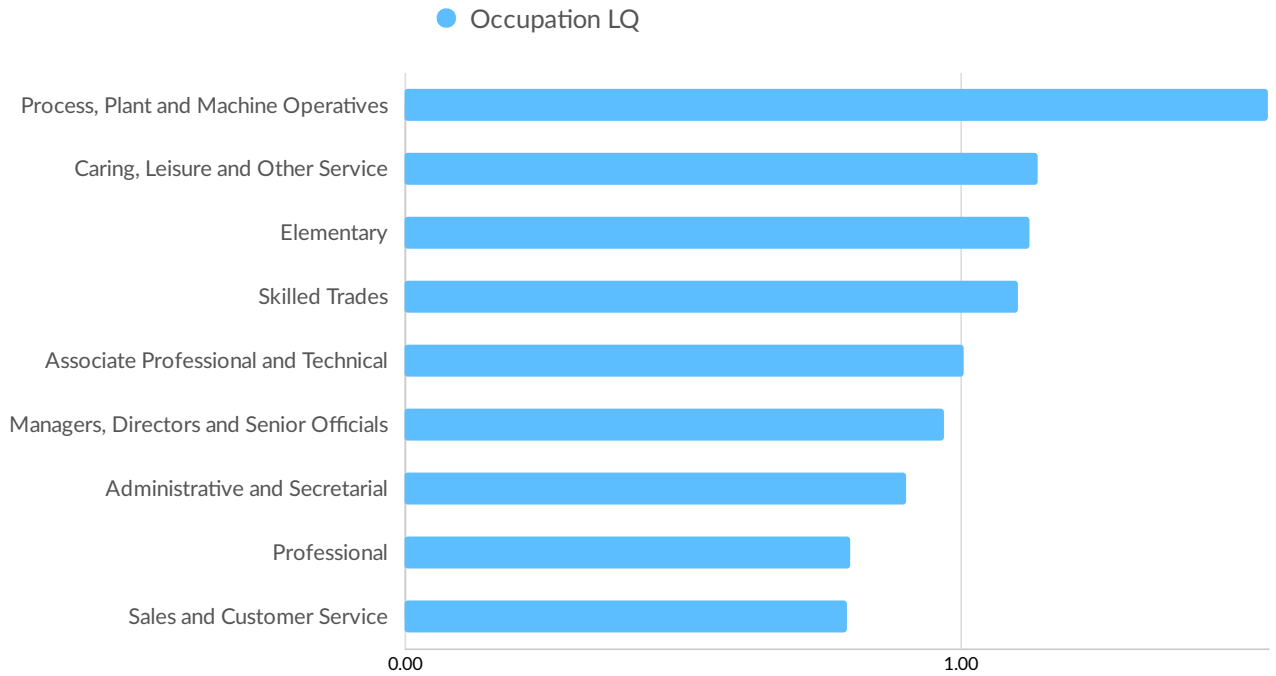
Largest Occupations



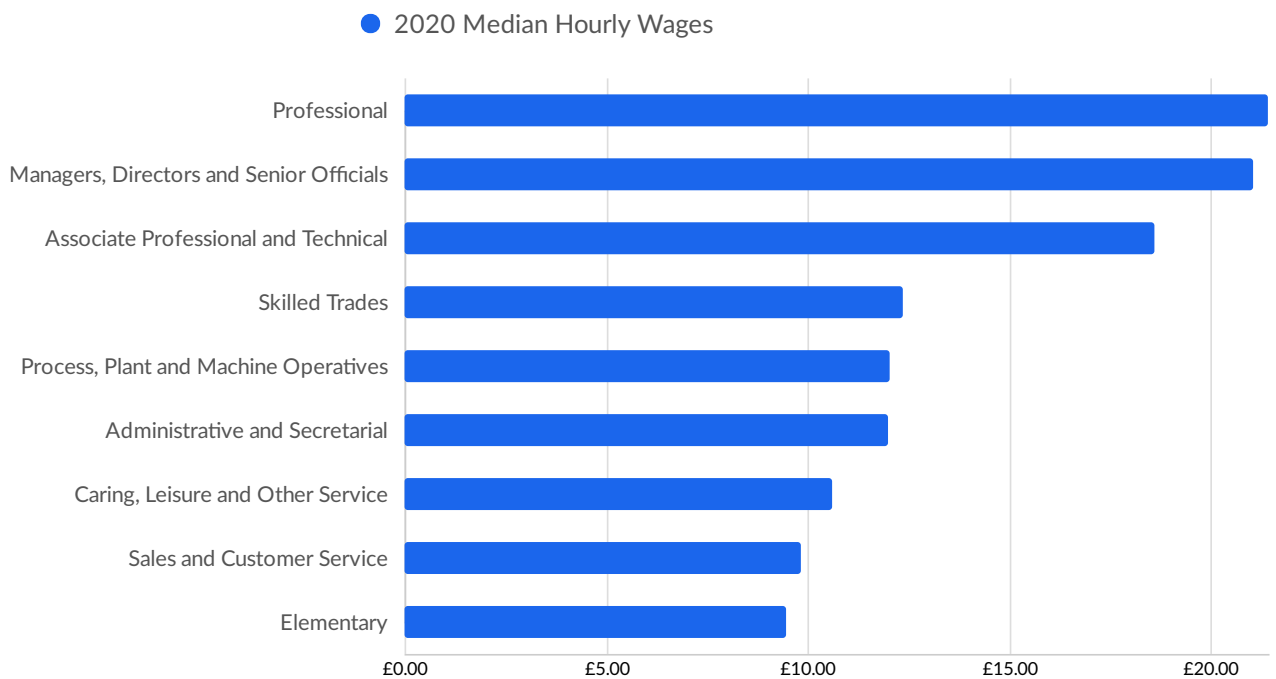
Top Growing Occupations



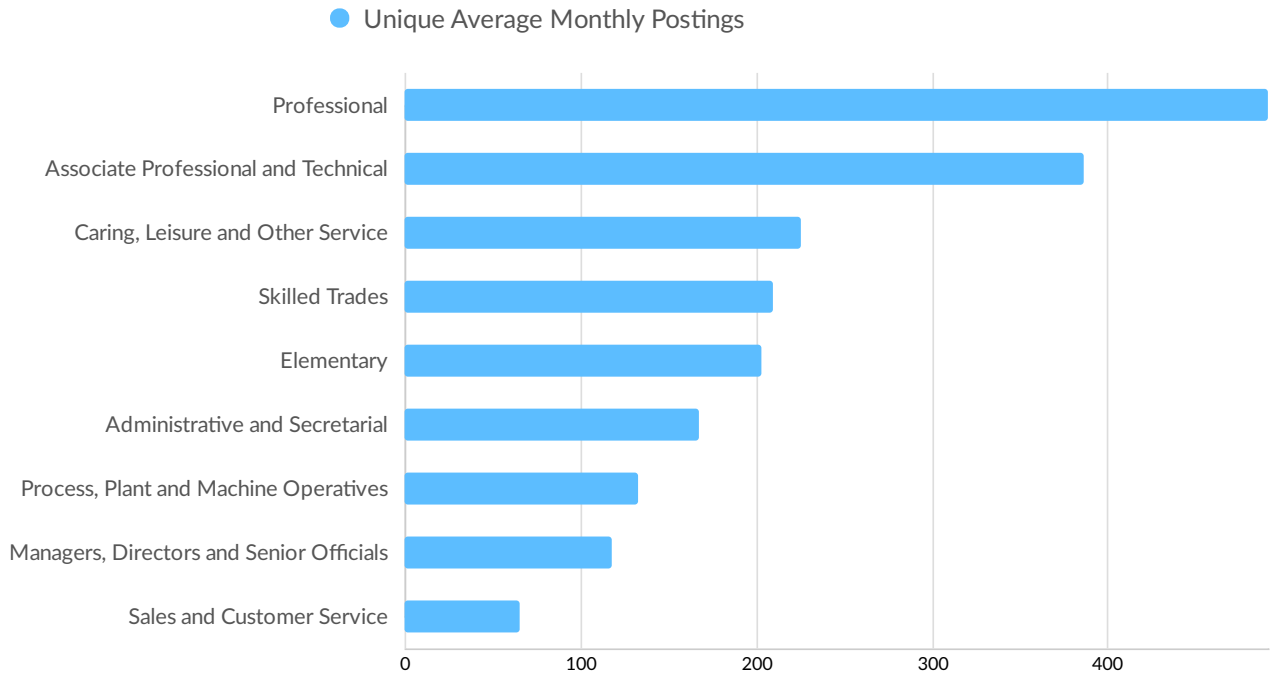
Top Occupation LQ



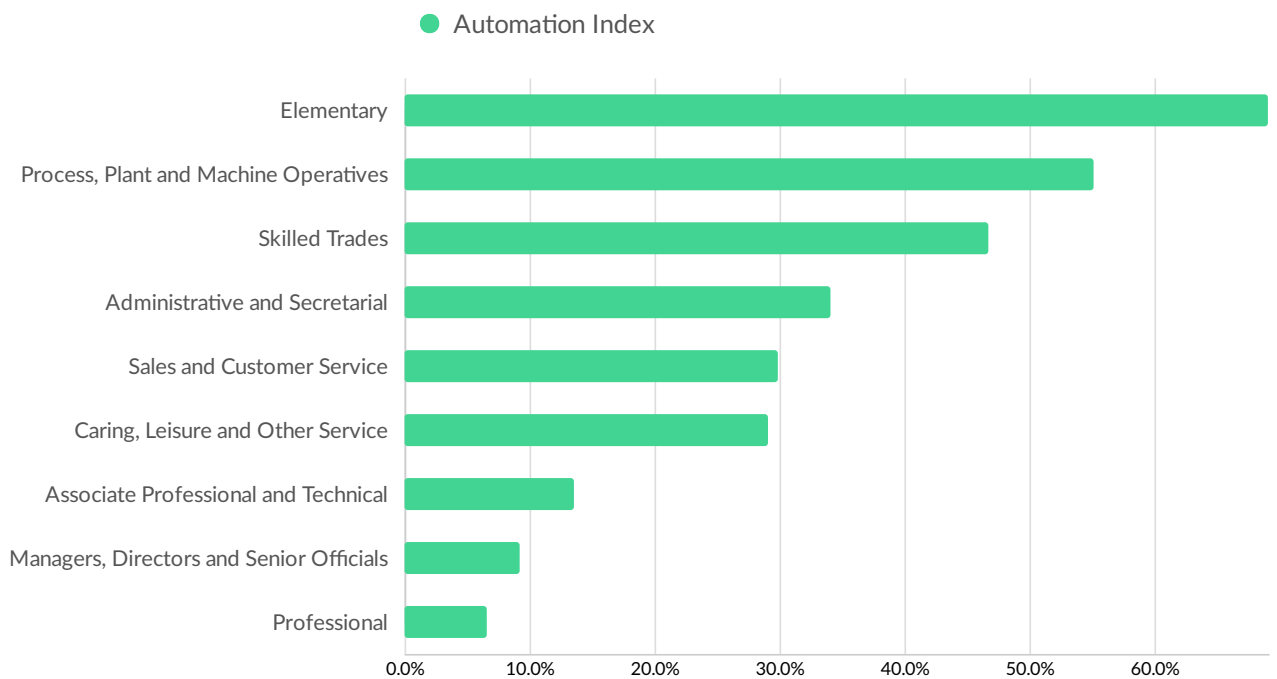
Top Occupation Wages
